

## 100 Mile and District Outriders General Meeting

February 2, 2010

Meeting called to order by President Ron Szigety at 17:45

- 1) **Call for Additional Agenda Items** - none received
- 2) **Call for Errors and Omissions of Previous Minutes**, none reported - Carolyn Dobbs motioned to accept minutes, Denise Little Seconded, all in favour, motion carried.
- 3) **Treasurer's Report** – quick report, we have \$9130.33 – Ceci Szigety motioned to accept, Gloria Melnychuck seconded, motion carried.
- 4) **Correspondence** –

  - Letter from South Cariboo Rodeo association wanting to book arena for May 23<sup>rd</sup>
  - Received arena drawing for bull pens and horse pens from C+ Rodeo
  - Second Annual Horse Bizzare held on March 27 -28 2010, 10 am to 5pm Saturday at Lakeside Equestrian Center on Tatton Road, Dinner and Auction held at Farrier Pub at 103, March 27<sup>th</sup>, 5:30pm – Randy Brodoway looking for different venues and products to participate, booths donated to clubs at no charge - put on by Sliders Club (new president is Dawwna Monk (congrats)
  - BC Registry Services sent back our registrar form with a need for correct date; it has been redone and resent.
- 5) **Old Business**

**Show Programs – Wendy Brown** – 10 copies distributed, final meeting, date to be announced by Show Committee – added under and over 19 liability waivers (quite detailed), and each little space has to be initialled in front and everything has to be filled out and signed on the back. Entry Checklist that you must include with package. Then there are the show rules that have been added to. **Please come to Show Committee meeting on Tuesday, February 16<sup>th</sup>, Kidston Land Surveying Office, to bring up any questions or changes.** Wild n' Woolly will be judge by Wendy Price – may need more review, pewee (8 and under), junior (9-13), intermediate (14-18) and senior (18+) age groups. Drivers will have a booklet. Fun n' Frolic will be judged by Jan Jollymore – Dressage followed by Jumping on Sat., English followed by Western on Sunday. Prices have changed somewhat. The Just Get Over it Classic, added the drive and jump. Fall Fair will be judged by Ellen Smailles – Halter and Western one day, English & Jumpers the following day. Only two shows have the high point awards (Wild n' Woolly and Fall Fair). Senior classes are \$7 per class, will be class awards at the Fall Fair. Don't have judges for Tail End (June 27<sup>th</sup>) or Halloween Show (October 3<sup>rd</sup>) yet, welcome suggestions. Carolyn made motion to allow the show committee to proceed with completion of show program and distribute them after the final meeting, Seconded by Ceci, all in favour, motion carried.

- 7) **Clinics** – Mike sent email Feb.8th that said **Lynne Larsen is officially booked for May 15 -16<sup>th</sup> to do a jumping clinic.**
- 8) **New Business** – Ken Huber was in an accident and received serious injuries, they will need a lot of help so Carolyn made motion to develop fund raising in aid of Ken, Carolyn Cook seconded, all in favour, motion carried. **Executive will figure this out on meeting on February 17, 2010.** Carol Robinson made motion to send flowers, Carolyn seconded it, and Carolyn will do this as treasurer.
- 9) **Ambassador Contest** – Carolyn Dobbs will spearhead this, and hasn't had a chance to look into it. Stephanie Doust might do it. Denise needs to know ASAP – she was told to go ahead and order the buckles because there are no dates on them anyway. Need two more sponsors if we are doing the contest – need to have a minimum of three contestants. Need advertising now.
- 10) **Tack/Clothing Swap**, Debbie Verboom suggested we do this at the Show Etiquette clinic for people to get ready for the show season.
- 11) **Calendar of Events** – Getting very full – Jen Felce is going to put 100 Mile Outrider events in bold font and then put as much as people wanted in the calendar yet make it clear that other people's events may not be correct, this is to the best of our knowledge.
- 12) **LBR (Little Britches Rodeo)** –announcer, Brian Baldry won't come for just one day so Ron S. is looking into another announcer; Mr. Dinwoodie, and we'll find out what his rates are. Denise Little said he is good and he won't charge \$800 as he will probably be announcing for the South Cariboo rodeo. One sponsorship in already, Denise has been looking into prizes; she needs a meeting to sit down with executive and whoever wants to be on LBR committee to go over some ideas. Ron S. read out portfolios for LBR: Cattle, Sheep, Goats, Calves, Judges, announcers, parade, arena, silent auction, greased pig contest, gate person, concession, and Carol Robinson has graciously accepted the role as volunteer coordinator, Linda and Jessie McMillan as well as Brenda Norfolk part of concession.
